GLASS (1 bin)

- Clean glass of all colors. Containers should be rinsed with no liquid, food waste, or other materials in them.
- Remove all caps or lids (they can go in the comingled/mixed box).
- Do NOT include ceramics, light bulbs, eye glasses, windows, or windshields. Remove glass from picture frames.



CARDBOARD (2 bins)

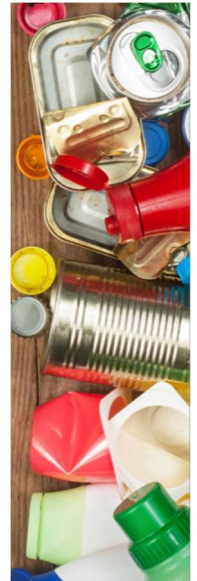
- Clean and dry cardboard. No food waste or very greasy materials should be included.
- Remove all internal packaging materials that are not cardboard (plastic wrap, styrofoam, paper).
- Flattening boxes is helpful and takes up less room.

COMINGLED / MIXED (2 bins)

- Paper - white paper, paperboard, newspaper, bags, mail, phone books, magazines, calendars, packing paper, craft paper. Do NOT include egg cartons, kleenex, paper towels, toilet paper, wax paper, shredded paper, or paper mache products.
- Clean aluminum or tin cans, lids and small items. Clean aluminum foil. Do NOT include pressurized or aerosol spray cans, stainless steel, or vehicle parts.
- Plastic - Clean hard plastic with recycle numbers 1 to 7. Containers should be rinsed with no liquid, food waste (peanut butter), or other materials in them.

Do NOT include:

- Styrofoam
- Plastic bags or film
- Plastic rings for beer or beverages
- Plastic buckets or trash cans
- Garden hoses
- Paper mail envelopes with plastic inserts
- Mixed material products like drink boxes, animal food bags, lined juice cartons



Items that CANNOT be include in these containers or recycled at this location:

- Tires, batteries, electronics (computers, laptops, tablets, televisions, fax or printer machines), appliances, furniture, mattresses, any wood products, fiberglass materials like furnace filters or golf clubs, sports equipment, clothes or cloth materials, leather products, suitcases, blinds, carpet, Christmas decorations or trees, etc. (If in good shape, try donating them to thrift shops or consult www.RecycleSpot.org for facilities in the greater Kansas City area)

Materials such as **oil, paint, pesticides, poisons**, etc. need to go to the **HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE** Collection Center, which is located in the Road and Bridge Building (to the West) and open on Wednesdays from 9:00 AM - 12:00 PM.
